

We have certainly seen many changes all around us this year and with the month of September, we will see even more changes as the season of fall brings cooler temperatures, new Christian Education opportunities, and new people to our church. This month we will begin our Sunday School classes for

children, Wednesday night studies for middle and high school students, and a new Adult Bible study, but they will all have changes from previous years. Sunday School for children will be done online with a series of excellent videos produced by our teachers; and confirmation and high school students will

meet on Wednesday nights through Zoom. (Please see page 5 in our newsletter for more information about these classes.)



Luke, and John, which record about 270 events, miracles, and teachings from Jesus' life. As a result, they all paint different pictures of Jesus. However, when you study all four Gospel accounts together it creates a beautiful picture of Jesus. Therefore, we will go through the events of Jesus' life using all four Gospels to better understand who they were writing to and why they included or excluded certain events of Jesus' life in their books.

The Bible study will be streamed live on Facebook and YouTube on Tuesdays, starting September 15, at 10:30am. If you cannot attend the study during the day, it will be recorded and posted on Facebook and YouTube so you can view it at your convenience. Each lesson is a stand-alone study that is not dependent on the previous lessons so that anyone can join the class at any time. Everyone is invited to join us as we study the following topics:

September 15: Christ, The Word - John 1:1-18

September 22: Jesus' Miraculous Birth - Matthew 1:18-2:12; Luke 2:1-20

September 29: John the Baptist and the Baptism of Jesus - Luke 3:1-20; Matthew 3:13-17 October 6: Jesus' Healing Ministry - Mark 1:40-45; Luke 7:1-9,11-17; Matthew 8:11-13

October 13: Parables On The Kingdom of Heaven - Matthew 13:1-50; Mark 4:21-29

October 20: Jesus, The Bread of Life - John 6:22-71 October 27: Jesus, The Good Shepherd - John 10:1-21 November 3: Jesus' Identity Is Questioned - John 10:22-42

November 10: The Lord's Supper - Luke 22:1-30


November 17: The Crucifixion - Matthew, Mark, Luke, John

November 24: The Resurrection - Matthew 27:62-28:15; John 20:1-18

On **Sunday, September 20**, we will have the joy of seeing 7 students confirm their faith in God. Our confirmation students are a tremendous blessing to our church and Confirmation Sunday is always a very special worship service for our church family. The students will publicly acknowledge the gifts of forgiveness, faith, and eternal life that God gave them in their Baptism and will promise to:

- Conform their lives to the Word of God.
- Remain faithful to God.
- Suffer death rather than fall away from God.

These are impressive promises that the students will make before God, their families, and our congregation. I realize all of you will not be able to attend this exciting worship service in person due to social distancing requirements, but the service will be streamed live and will be recorded for everyone to enjoy on Facebook and YouTube.

The whole confirmation process involves many people and actually begins for the students at their baptism. When parents bring their children to church for baptism, they promise to raise their children in the Christian faith, pray for them, and bring them to worship on a regular basis. In order to assist parents, the church has designed a period of instruction to help students identify with the life and mission of the Christian Church.
