July 19-23, 2025

Every three years our Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS) denomination hosts a National Youth Gathering where over 20,000 high school youth and adults from across the country and around the world come together to worship, serve, spend time in God's Word, and enjoy fellowship with other LCMS youth. The Gatherings are an exciting vehicle by which the Church

reaches out to, cares for, equips, and affirms young people for ministry and service in a variety of settings in their congregations and communities. I have attended several of these gatherings over the past 30 years and it is one of the best events put on by our church denomination.



This year the gathering will take place in New Orleans, Louisiana under the theme "Endure," based on Hebrews 12:1-3, which states: Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ²looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. ³Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted.

The goals under the theme of "Endure" are to help students look to Jesus to find strength to endure in both good times and bad; to see how they need the church and how the church needs them; and to encourage them to persevere in the faith and to live in joyful service to others. 
