2026: Our Silver Jubilee

We like to celebrate anniversaries. Silver and gold wedding anniversaries are important milestones in people's lives. Workers celebrate 10, 20, 30, or 40 years with a company. A 100th anniversary of a church or a school is definitely an exciting event.

In the Old Testament, God required people to celebrate certain years by glorifying him for His wonderful works. Every 7th and 50th years were to be special events in their lives. After celebrating seven, seven-year anniversaries, the 50th year was to be a year of jubilee. The theme of the jubilee year was freedom (see Leviticus 25:23-38). Prisoners were set free, slaves were released, debts were forgiven, and all property was returned to its original owners. In addition, all labor was to cease for one year.

I think the "Jubilee" represents a great picture of the church. Jesus came to free us from our sin, as the debt of sin we owe to God was paid on the cross as Jesus died on our behalf. As a result we are no longer slaves to sin, having been freed by Christ, and we can truly rest in God's love as we no longer have to work at making ourselves acceptable to God by our own works.

This year marks our 25th anniversary as a congregation, as the church was chartered in October 2001. Therefore, I would like to celebrate this milestone all throughout the year under the theme, "Our Silver Jubilee." I would like to do some special activities each month leading up to our 25th anniversary at the end of October, such as highlighting 25 great blessings God has given to our church, bringing in some of our former church workers to celebrate with us, and putting together a special celebration on our anniversary weekend on **October 24-25, 2026**.

I would like to begin our "Silver Jubilee" year with a sermon series titled, "We Are The Church Together." We will look at Paul's words to the church in 1 Corinthians as we consider the amazing things God has done through all of you in building our church to be people who Share His Word and Live His Love with others. We will begin this year with our Epiphany celebration, remembering how the Wise Men followed a star to for the sole purpose of worshipping Jesus. They set a great example for us and I pray you will join us for the following worship services as we kick off our "Silver Jubilee."


