he was very grateful for our donation, which will go towards rebuilding the cabins and helping to feed those who used to live near the camp, but lost their homes and everything in them as a result of the hurricane.

I know several of our members have gone to the mountains to help with the recovery efforts at Camp Linn Haven and Mountainside Lutheran Church, as well as at Trinity Lutheran Church in Tryon, NC. Thank you for your generosity of time in going to the mountains to help, for sharing your talents in assisting people in the rebuilding process, and for your loving financial gifts which help tremendously with the recovery efforts.
