# A Chat With Pastor...

"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ." - 2 Peter 3:18

Many of you know that I am a runner and whenever I run I time myself hoping to go a little faster each week. In order to get faster and stronger I have learned that I need to practice running 3 or 4 days a week, which is a lot of work.

Peter writes in the verse listed above that we are to grow in the knowledge and grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. What he's telling us, and all Christians, is that we must practice our faith. Seems like odd advice, doesn't it? I mean, either we believe in Jesus as our Savior or we don't. Right? Peter, though, doesn't think it is that simple. His point is that we have to continue to grow in faith once we come to faith. We have to continue to show our faith, visibly, on a daily basis. In other words, we have to walk the walk as well as talk the talk.

So how do we grow in our faith? Practice, and practicing our faith involves participating in worship, praying, serving others, and spending time in God's Word. The theme we have emphasized for our church this year is Courageous Generosity. Last month we looked at different ways to be generous with our love and this month I would like us to consider how we can be generous with our witness, which I think is a great way to practice our faith. 
# Children's Ministry
