The woman explained, "When my grandmother would fix dinner for the family as I was growing up, she would always tell us at the end of the meal as she was clearing the dishes from the table to 'keep your fork,' which meant dessert was coming and my grandmother always made wonderful desserts. So I want people to see me in my casket someday with a fork in my hand so they will know that this life is not the end, there is more to come, something wonderful, eternal life with God in heaven."

Therefore, I would like to do a sermon series this month, leading up to Thanksgiving titled, "More To Come," as a reminder that this life is not the end, there is more to come someday when we will see our God face to face.
